

WHAT IS A CLEAN SWEEP?

It is a voluntary, state/county program for the legal, safe and convenient disposal of hazardous wastes from homes, farms and businesses. The Clean Sweep program has been operating since 1990.

WHY SHOULD I PARTICIPATE?

Hazardous chemicals can cause health, safety, or environmental problems. Improperly stored or disposed chemicals can pollute ground and surface waters. Participants will not be held liable for the proper disposal of materials collected.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

All Adams County residents can participate.

IS THERE A COST TO PARTICIPATE?

Households and farms are allowed to dispose of hazardous waste **without charge; however, quantities may be restricted.**

HOW TO PREPARE FOR THE DAY

Load your vehicle/trailer with unloading in mind:

- Keep like materials together and in boxes—see other side. Materials will be taken off at different stations so plan ahead.
- Hazardous materials will be taken off last so plan accordingly
- Use cash or checks for quickness. Credit/debit cards accepted for large loads in the office only (extra fee).
- Prepare to wait—this is a popular event that only happens every 2 yrs.

SPECIAL NOTE: Mercury thermometers have a silver liquid—not a red liquid.

WHAT ELSE IS THERE TO KNOW?

The following can be brought in all year long as listed below. They will also be accepted the day of the Clean Sweep.

- Latex paint, antifreeze and oil are accepted at the landfill—ask us how.
- TV's are \$15.00, computer monitors and laptops/tablets are \$5.00. All other electronics are free.
- Compacts and fluorescent bulbs .55 cents for 4' & under, \$1.10 for 8'.

CLEAN SWEEP GUIDELINES

Agricultural pre-registration is mandatory. Contact us for the forms. Friday disposal may be available for Ag materials.

Each **household** may bring up to, and no more than, a combination of five gallons of liquid or 50 pounds of solid waste NOT including latex paint.

Materials should be properly identified in their original containers with original labels.

Unknown materials can be brought in, but may be refused if the contractor cannot dispose of it, or if disposal costs are excessive.

If your volume of unknown materials exceeds five gallons or 50 pounds, contact the landfill in advance to make **required** special arrangements.

Do not mix substances together! Doing so can be extremely dangerous.

Pack materials safely. Place waste in a cardboard box lined with a plastic bag and separate each product with folded newspaper. Items must be boxed to speed up unloading.

Keep paints separated from other materials for removal before entering the hazardous waste line. This will speed up the process also.

TIRE AND APPLIANCE ROUND-UP GUIDELINES

Only Tires & Appliances are 1/2 price. Electronics & TV's are billed the usual fees (see other side).

TIRES

Car & Light truck: \$1.50 off rim, \$2.50 on rim, *up to 10*.

Car & Light truck tire loads over 10, Semi-truck tires, Tractor tires, and all mixed loads and/or bulk loads will be charged *by weight only* at half price of \$.0475 per pound.
