The final estimate of the January 1, 2006 population for Adams County is 21,548. This represents a change of 1,628 persons (8.173 percent) since the 2000 census.

Approximately 17,386 of the estimated population for the County of Adams are of voting age. The County's voting age population is the summation of the voting age population for all communities within the County. This approximate is a courtesy estimate which helps you comply with Wisconsin Statutes 5.66 which requires municipal clerks to approximate the number of electors prior to election. The voting age population was calculated by applying the census proportion of persons over 18 to the final January 1st estimate, and then multiplying the result by a state-wide factor to account for the general aging of population.
