




# Adams County Recycling Guide Do's...

# and Don'ts

Material	Preparation	Recommendations	
<b>Corrugated Cardboard</b>  (look for ribbed, wavy layer)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Flatten the cardboard</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Separate and string-bind soda, beer, and cereal boxes from corrugated material. Keep clean and dry.</li> </ul> 	No wax coated material No packing material (Styrofoam, plastic bags or strapping) No food waste
<b>Plastic Containers</b>  	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Remove &amp; Discard caps</li> <li>•Rinse</li> <li>•Flatten (to save space)</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Place plastic in proper bin</li> <li>•Caps must be discarded</li> <li>Look for recycling symbol with appropriate number</li> <li>•Must be empty and clean</li> </ul>	Do not tie together Do not place bags or boxes in receptacle No motor oil or antifreeze containers, discard please
<b>Glass Bottles &amp; Jars Only</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Rinse</li> <li>•Remove &amp; Discard lids</li> <li>•Labels OK</li> <li>•Separate by color (clear, brown, green/blue)</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Must be empty &amp; clean</li> <li>•No food waste should remain</li> </ul>	No ceramics, light bulbs, window glass, dishes, drinking glasses, or fluorescent bulbs 
<b>Aluminum &amp; Tin Cans</b>  Clean paint cans, empty aerosol cans, aluminum cans, tin cans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Rinse</li> </ul>  Labels OK, may flatten	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Must be empty &amp; clean</li> <li>•No food waste should remain</li> <li>•Clean foil &amp; pie pans OK</li> </ul>	<b>No Garbage or Food Wastes should remain in glass, aluminum, paper, cardboard or tin.</b>
<b>Mixed Office Paper</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Bundle &amp; tie office paper with string</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Office paper (any color), and window envelopes OK</li> <li>•No paper clips or binders</li> </ul>	
<b>Newspaper</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Bundle &amp; tie newspaper with string</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Newspaper, catalogs, phone books with cover, and advertising material OK</li> <li>•Remove &amp; discard plastic wrappers</li> </ul>	
<b>Magazines &amp; Glossy Catalogs</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Bundle &amp; tie magazines with string</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Readers Digests and TV Guides OK</li> </ul>	No plastic wraps on magazines (discard) No phone books

All recyclables should be CLEAN and DRY and free of food waste!

## The following items are accepted at the Recycling Center:

**BATTERIES** Lead acid batteries can be dropped off at the center, free of charge.



**USED OIL** Recycle your motor oil from cars, boats, motorcycles, and lawn mowers free of charge.

**OIL FILTERS**  
**ANTIFREEZE**



Drain your oil into a reusable, sealable container, such as milk cartons and bring to the Recycling Center. After emptying, discard container in garbage or reuse. Antifreeze can also be taken to the Recycling Center in separate containers at no cost.

**IMPORTANT!!** Don't mix your oil with solvents such as paint thinner or antifreeze. When they are combined with oil, the oil is no longer recyclable.

**APPLIANCES** There is a \$15.00 fee for each appliance brought to the Recycling Center. We do not offer pickup service. (Prices subject to change with markets)



**FLUORESCENT BULBS** 4' bulbs, 8' bulbs, Mercury Vapor Lamp  
Call for prices - Small fee is based on size.

**TIRES** There will be a \$3.00 charge per tire. There is an additional \$2.00 charge for tires on rims.



**SCRAP METAL** All scrap metals accepted free of charge.

**SHARPS** Small fee based on size.

**COMPUTERS & COMPONENTS** Accepted free of charge.
